The Impact of Addiction

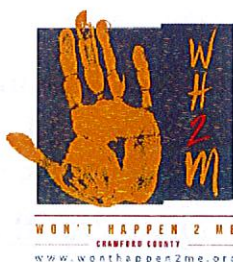

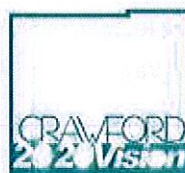
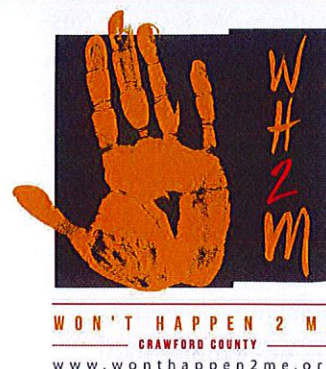
